West Heights Area, 1977

This revealing aerial view image was taken by Mark Brett from an aircraft flown by Klahanie Air Ltd. (Mission) in 1977.

The image captures a west to east view of what the residential area known as West Heights looked like more than four decades ago. The main road running diagonally in the foreground is Wren Street at Westview Avenue. Other streets shown off Wren are 7th Avenue and Van Velzen and in the foreground off of Westview - (on left) Lark, Quail, Oriole and (on right) Cottonwood.

Of note, the green spaces shown on Hurd Street (2nd street east of Wren) still exist today. One site is the former property of the Mission Lawn Bowling Club which is currently slated for future development as a community arts and culture centre.

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
