On November 15th, 1980, a referendum to approve the borrowing \$2.3 million for the indoor pool-recreation complex was approved by over 64% with 1,581 in favour and 873 against.

Built by Key Construction Ventures of Vancouver, the new indoor swimming pool was officially opened by Mayor John Agnew on Friday, November 12, 1982. The new complex included 3 racquet ball courts, an exercise and weight room as well as a Jacuzzi whirlpool and saunas.
